

1. Each side nominates five players (still playing at the end of the game) to take a penalty.
2. These players then take their penalty, the teams taking them in alternate order.
3. When each side has taken its five penalties the team scoring the most goals is the winner (but see below).
4. If at some stage a team is in an unbeatable position (for example, 3-1 up with only one penalty left to take for each team), then the shoot-out stops at that point.
5. If the scores are level after the five penalties have been taken by both sides, the shoot-out continues on a sudden death basis, the winner being the first team to score when their opponents have not scored.
